- Public witness action on the CLE in downtown DC Noon – 3 PM Friday, March 9 (optional)

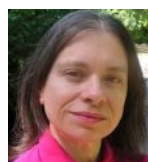
Plenary Speakers

Rev. Dr. Johnny M. Hunter is National Director of the Life Education And Resource Network (LEARN, Inc.) and President of Global Life & Family Mission. He also serves as Pastor of Praise and Worship at Cliffdale Community Church in Fayetteville, NC; and is a consultant specializing in goal-oriented racial diversity training and organization. He is winner of numerous awards including the Dr. Martin Luther King Religious Leadership Award, Sojourner Truth Award, and Defender of Life Award.



Dr. Catherine Meeks is retired as Clara Carter Acree Distinguished Professor of Social Science and Professor of Socio-Cultural Studies at Wesleyan College. Dr. Meeks' books include *Standing on Their Shoulders: A Celebration of the Wisdom of African American Women* and *Bears and Butterflies: A Way to Listen to Your Hearts*. She writes regularly for *The Huffington Post*. Dr. Meeks has won numerous awards, including NAACP Outstanding Community Service Award, W.E.B. Dubois Award for Outstanding Service to the African American Community, and Georgia Sociologist of the Year.

Aimee Bedoy is a 2011 graduate of Carnegie Mellon University. She served as President of the CMU Life Matters Club for two years. In August 2011, she founded *Life Matters Journal*, and currently serves as its Executive Editor. This quarterly journal is dedicated to opening a forum for discourse on all issues related to human life and dignity. Ms. Bedoy seeks to unify the movement for all human life across boundaries of religion, politics and lifestyle. She will speak on reaching the younger generation about the CLE.



Rachel MacNair is CL Vice President and Director of our research arm, the Institute for Integrated Social Analysis. She also serves as President-Elect of the Peace Psychology Division of the American Psychological Association. She is a past President of Feminists for Life of America, and the founder of the Feminism and Nonviolence Studies Association. She has written or edited, alone or with others, a number of books, including *Consistently Opposing Killing: From Abortion to Assisted Suicide, the Death Penalty and War*, and *Perpetration-Induced Traumatic Stress: The psychological consequences of killing*.
